The Stark County Courthouse is the third to occupy this same site. The first, a two-story Federal style structure erected in 1817-18, was replaced by a larger Italianate structure in 1868-70, with a separate Annex (q.v.). But within less than two decades, the second Courthouse was deemed inadequate.
